According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, Emergency Managers earned an average of \$49,350 per year in 2004 (nationwide average). In the Southern California area, Emergency Managers can expect to earn between \$65,000 and \$120,000 annually. We expect to see an 18.3% increase in the number of jobs available in emergency management between 2002 and 2012.
