

## Grades & Grade Points

<b>A = Excellent</b>	<b>4 grade points per unit</b>
<b>B = Good</b>	<b>3 grade points per unit</b>
<b>C = Satisfactory</b>	<b>2 grade points per unit</b>
<b>D = Passing-less than satisfactory</b>	<b>1 grade point per unit</b>
<b>F = Failing</b>	<b>0 grade points per unit</b>

The grade point average is calculated by dividing the number of grades points by the number of units attempted for the grades of A, B, C, D, or F.

### HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR GPA (example):

Class	GPA units (Units Attempted)	Grade Received	Units Earned	times	Grade Points Per Unit	equals	Total Grade Points Earned
Biology C100	3.....	A	3	x	4	=	12
Biology C101	1.....	A	1	x	4	=	4
Psychology C00	3.....	B	3	x	3	=	9
Math C115	4.....	C	4	x	2	=	8
Art C100	3.....	B	3	x	3	=	9
History C100	3.....	F	0	x	0	=	0
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>17</b>						<b>42</b>

$$42 \text{ (Grade Pts)} \div \text{by } 17 \text{ (Units Attempted)} = 2.47 \text{ (GPA)}$$

The following grades are not part of the GPA calculation: P/CR, NP/NCR, W, MW, I, IB, IC, ID, IF, INP, IP or RD
